WHEREAS, On May 25, 2022, City Council authorized a construction services contract for the replacement and rehabilitation of water and wastewater mains at 13 locations, in an amount not to exceed \$13,921,735.00, by Resolution No. 22-0816; and

WHEREAS, On April 10, 2024, City Council authorized an increase in the construction services contract for additional work associated with the installation of water services, large valve manholes, dewatering efforts for construction, and additional paving and surface restoration work, in an amount not to exceed \$750,410.00, increasing the contract amount from \$13,921,735.00 to \$14,672,145.00, by Resolution No. 24-627; and

WHEREAS, additional work is required for the emergency replacement of an 18-inch diameter sanitary sewer pipeline at 10750 Maylee Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, Douglas Dailey Construction, LLC, 2005 Bluff Springs Road, Ferris, Texas 75125, has submitted an acceptable proposal for this additional work; and

WHEREAS, Dallas Water Utilities recommends that Contract No. 21-341/342 be increased by \$412,280.00, from \$14,672,145.00 to \$15,084,425.00.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That an increase in the construction services contract with Douglas Dailey Construction, LLC (Change Order No. 2) is authorized for additional work associated with the emergency replacement of an 18-inch diameter sanitary sewer pipeline at 10750 Maylee Boulevard, in an amount not to exceed \$412,280.00, increasing the contract amount from \$14,672,145.00 to \$15,084,425.00.

SECTION 2. That the proposed Change Order No. 2 with Douglas Dailey Construction, LLC, be accepted, and that Contract No. 21-341/342 be revised accordingly.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$412,280.00 to Douglas Dailey Construction, LLC from the Wastewater Capital Improvement F Fund, Fund 4116, Department DWU, Unit PS40, Object 4560, Program 721342, Encumbrance/Contract No. CX-DWU-2022-00018851, Vendor VC21437.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
