WHEREAS, the City of Dallas owns and operates two wastewater treatment plants with a combined, permitted capacity of 280 million gallons per day and the Central Wastewater Treatment Plant (CWWTP) provides treatment for northern and western portions of the City and is permitted to treat an average annual flow of 170 million gallons per day; and

WHEREAS, engineering services are required to provide major maintenance improvements at Central Wastewater Treatment Plant to ensure reliable and quality wastewater service to our customers and regulatory permit compliance; and

WHEREAS, Gresham Smith, 222 Second Avenue South, Suite 1400, Nashville, TN 37201, was selected as the most highly qualified proposer and has submitted an acceptable proposal to provide these engineering services.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the proposal submitted by Gresham Smith, Contract No. DWU-2025-00027465, in the amount of \$2,996,569.00, be approved and the consultant be authorized to perform the required engineering services.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a professional services contract with Gresham Smith, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to provide engineering services associated with major maintenance improvements at the Central Wastewater Treatment Plant, in an amount not to exceed \$2,996,569.00.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$2,996,569.00 to Gresham Smith, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract, as follows:
