WHEREAS, the City of Dallas finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Dallas that the projects listed in Attachment A be operated for the Fiscal Year 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the projects as required by the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office grant application; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the City of Dallas assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas designates the City Manager as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas designates the Chief Financial Officer as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to submit applications for a series of grant projects from the Texas Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office to provide an endeavor to enhance preparedness and build capacity to prepare for, prevent, and respond to terrorist attacks for the fiscal year 2026. Attachment A lists the following grant projects that will be applied for by the Office of Emergency Management and Crisis Response for the fiscal year 2026.

SECTION 2. That the City of Dallas designates the City Manager or designee as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
