WHEREAS, on June 26, 2019, the City Council authorized a five-year service contract for maintenance and support of the existing court case and content management system with Tyler Technologies, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$3,858,968.00, by Resolution No. 19-1025; and

WHEREAS, on September 20, 2019, Administrative Action No. 19-6566 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the service contract with Tyler Technologies, Inc. to the City's maintenance and support and hosting services contract for incode court case management system to allow a pilot program for Smart Texting functionality, with zero costs, having no effect on the contract amount; and

WHEREAS, on December 3, 2019, Administrative Action No. 19-7017 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 2 to the service contract with Tyler Technologies, Inc. to the City's maintenance and support and hosting services contract for incode court case management system to add a revised exhibit to clarify online transaction fee prices, with zero cost, having no effect on the contract amount; and

WHEREAS, on December 17, 2019, Administrative Action No. 19-7084 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 3 to the service contract with Tyler Technologies, Inc. to the City's maintenance and support and hosting services contract for incode court case management system for a data fix in an amount not to exceed \$2,500.00, from \$3,858,968.00 to \$3,861,468.00; and;

WHEREAS, on December 8, 2021, the City Council authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 4 to increase the service contract with Tyler Technologies, Inc. for maintenance and support of the existing court case and content management system in an amount not to exceed \$259,016.00, from \$3,861,468.00 to \$4,120,484.00, by Resolution No. 21-1992; and

WHEREAS, on June 26, 2024, Administrative Action No. 24-5884 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 5 with contract savings for continued services and support of the Court Case Management and e-Citation Systems, and addition of Payment PCI and Gateway components with Tyler Technology. Dates 6/11/2024 thru 6/10/2025, zero costs, with zero cost, having no effect on the contract amount.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute Supplemental Agreement No. 6 to increase the service contract with Tyler Technologies, Inc. (VS0000052675), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for ongoing maintenance and support for the daily operations of the court case management system, in an amount not to exceed \$2,950,523.00, increasing the contract amount from \$4,120,484.00 to \$7,071,007.00.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$2,950,523.00 (subject to annual appropriations) to Tyler Technologies, Inc. from Service Contract No. DSV-2018-0008160.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
