WHEREAS on January 25, 2017, City Council authorized an acquisition contract for the purchase and implementation of a fire inspection system in the amount of \$210,490; and a five-year service contract for hosting, maintenance, and support for a fire inspection system in the amount of \$1,017,405 with Xerox Government Systems LLC, in a total amount not to exceed \$1,227,895, by Resolution No. 17-0178; and

WHEREAS on February 6, 2019, Administrative Action No. 19-5264 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the service contract for the reassignment of the web-based fire inspection system from Xerox Government Systems, LLC to ESO Solutions, Inc.; and

WHEREAS on May 17, 2019, Administrative Action No. 19-5990 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 2 to the service contract for the reassignment of the web-based fire inspection system from ESO Solutions, Inc. to Streamline Automation Systems, LLC; and

WHEREAS on August 5, 2020, Administrative Action No. 20-5808 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 3 to increase the existing contract with Streamline Automation Systems, LLC, in an amount not to exceed \$34,192, from \$1,227,895 to \$1,262,087 for the inclusion of a customer-facing portal for the City's web-based fire inspection system.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute Supplemental Agreement No. 4 to the service contract with Streamline Automation Systems, LLC (VS100306), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for hosting, maintenance, and support of the existing fire inspection system for the Fire-Rescue Department managed by the Department of Information and Technology Services, in an amount not to exceed \$558,225, increasing the contract amount from \$1,262,087 to \$1,820,312.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$558,225.00 (subject to annual appropriations) to Streamline Automation Systems, LLC from Service Contract No. POM-2016-00001492.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
