

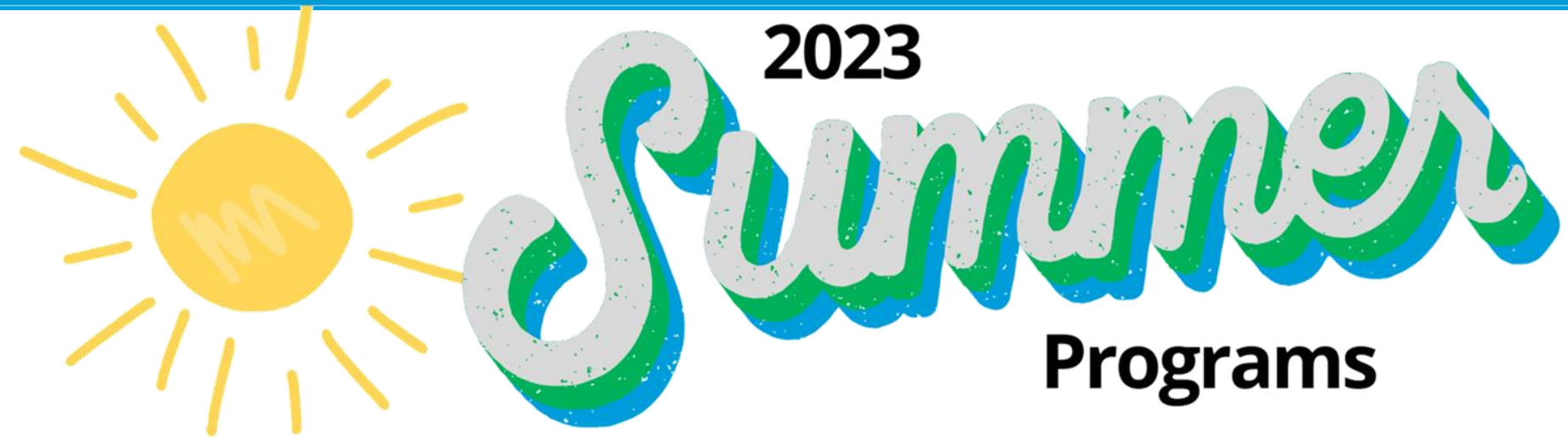

Outdoor recreation focusing on fishing, geocaching, mountain biking, kayaking, nature photography, survival skills, and outdoor education.

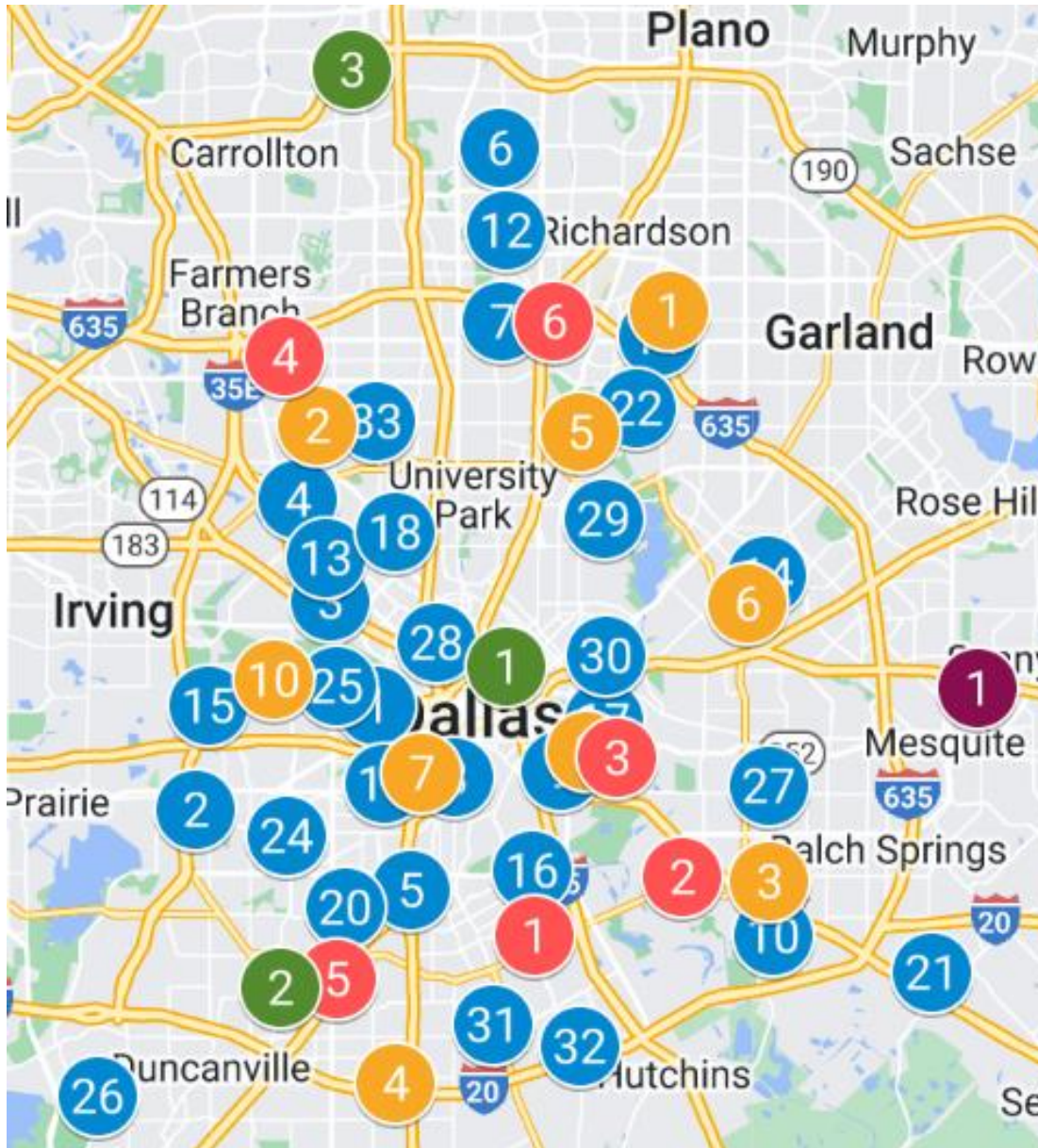
