4. BRIEFING & DISCUSSION ITEM(S)

a. Trial Board Scheduling Update

Mr. Davis provided the Board with a Trial Board Scheduling update. He informed the Board that Civil Service currently has 14 pending Trial Board hearings. Despite the challenges on scheduling these hearings, the department has been able to schedule all pending hearings through June.

Chair Welch requested the Civil Service department and the Board to work as expeditiously as possible to get the remaining pending Trial Board hearings scheduled before the June 2023 Board meeting.

b. Departmental Updates and Announcements

Mr. Davis provided an update on the CVS Recruitment and Examining unit hiring events and job fairs' participation throughout September 2022.

The CVS team is scheduled to assist Dallas Fire-Rescue with its upcoming Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) on October 3rd, 14th, 17th, 22nd, 24th & 28th. On the promotional activity, Dallas Fire-Rescue written exam was held at Kay Bailey Hutchison Convention Center on August 29th. There were 113 candidates; 87 took the exam and 69 passed. Dallas Fire-Rescue Lieutenant written exam was held on September 20th. There were 232 candidates scheduled; 194 candidates took the exam. Dallas Fire-Rescue Driver Engineer was announced on September 14th and posted through October 14th.
