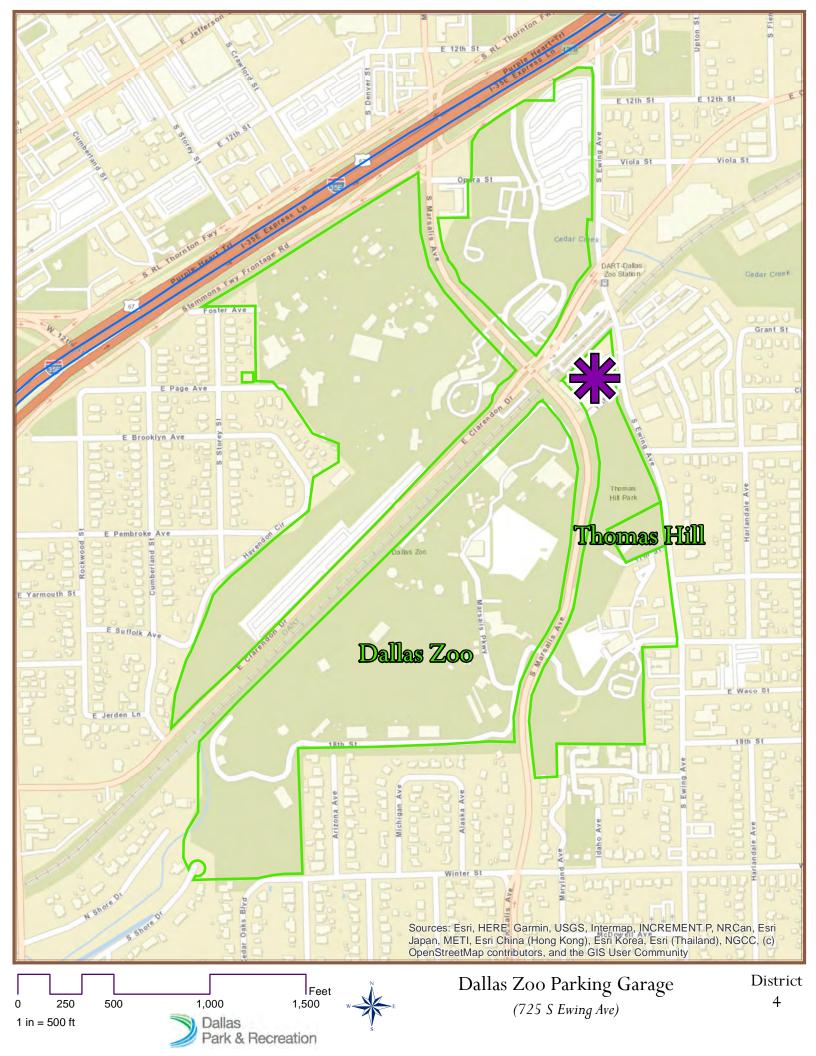

### **BACKGROUND**

On October 20, 2023, the City of Dallas advertised a re-bid request for competitive sealed proposals for the construction of the Anita Nañez Martinez Recreation Center Building envelope repairs with bids due November 9, 2023. The re-bid effort was desired as the initial bid for this project on September 8, 2023 resulted in several non-responsive bids. A pre-proposal conference was held on October 25, 2023 with two potential proposer(s) in attendance

In response to the advertisement, the Office of Procurement Services received submittals from five firms on November 9, 2023. The bid procurement process complied with the City's Administrative Directive 4-5: Contracting Policy, Section 10 Procurement Processes.

This action will award a construction services contract for the Anita Nañez Martinez Recreation Center Building Envelope Repairs project located at 3212 North Winnetka Avenue to York Builders, Inc, the best value proposer of five, in an amount not to exceed \$1,160,269.20. The scope of work includes total replacement of existing damaged exterior façade gypsum fiber reinforced concrete decorative panel bands with cast stone panels on three facades, repairs of several existing steel framed windows, repairs of cracks on the exterior plaster finish on gymnasium exterior walls, repairs on the gymnasium athletic wood floor, painting of the gymnasium interior, and preparing and painting interior drywall surfaces adjacent to exterior windows scheduled for repairs, and exterior cement plaster repairs to the gymnasium.

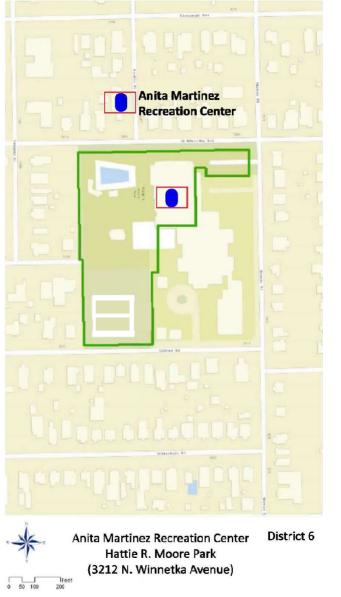

### **BACKGROUND**

This item authorizes the acquisition of a hike and bike trail easement from AV Prestonwood Trails, LLC of approximately 14,454 square feet (0.33 acres) of land located at 6350 Keller Springs Road for the Cotton Belt Trail Project (Project) (**Exhibit A**). The total purchase price for this acquisition is \$17,500.00 based on an independent appraisal (\$14,5000.00, plus closing costs and title expenses not to exceed \$3,000.00).

The Project is a collaboration between the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG), DART, and local governments, namely Grapevine, Coppell, Carrollton, Addison, Dallas, Richardson, and Plano. When completed, the Cotton Belt Trail will extend over twenty-four miles providing connections into many local governments' trail networks across the DFW area including the extensive Dallas Trail Network.

The Project has been designed and is being constructed concurrent with DART's Silver Line project. The construction of critical project construction areas is nearing completion for Phase 1. Phase 2 requires acquisition of an easement area at 6350 Keller Springs Road. Additional acquisitions for Phase 2 are also required and will be presented to the Board in the future.

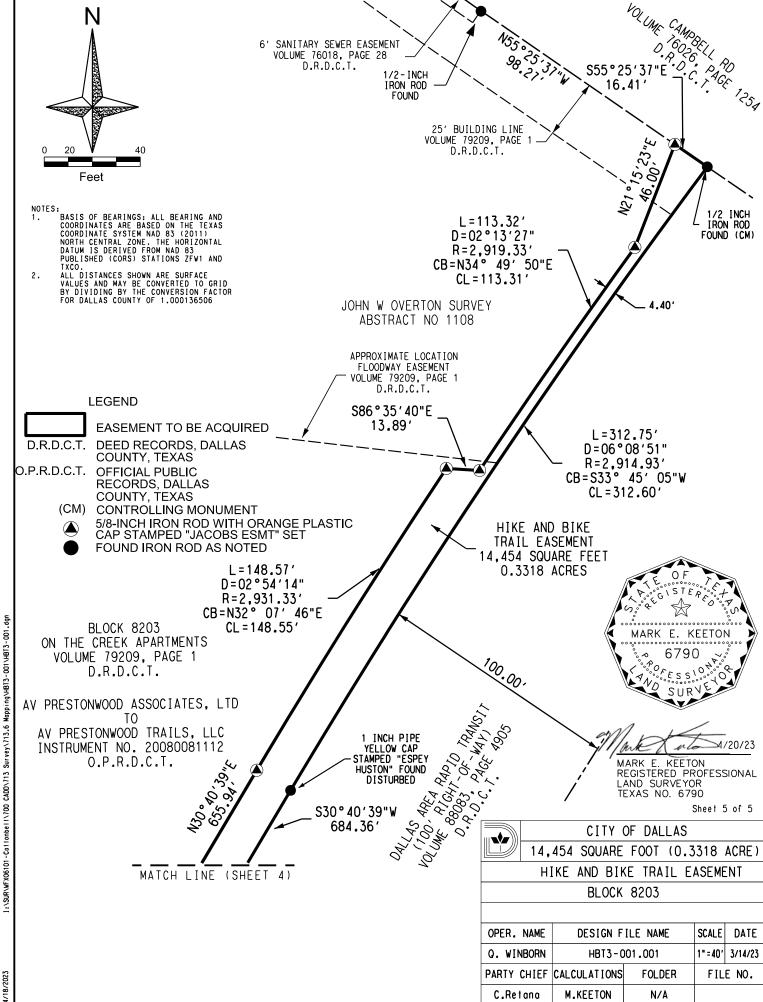

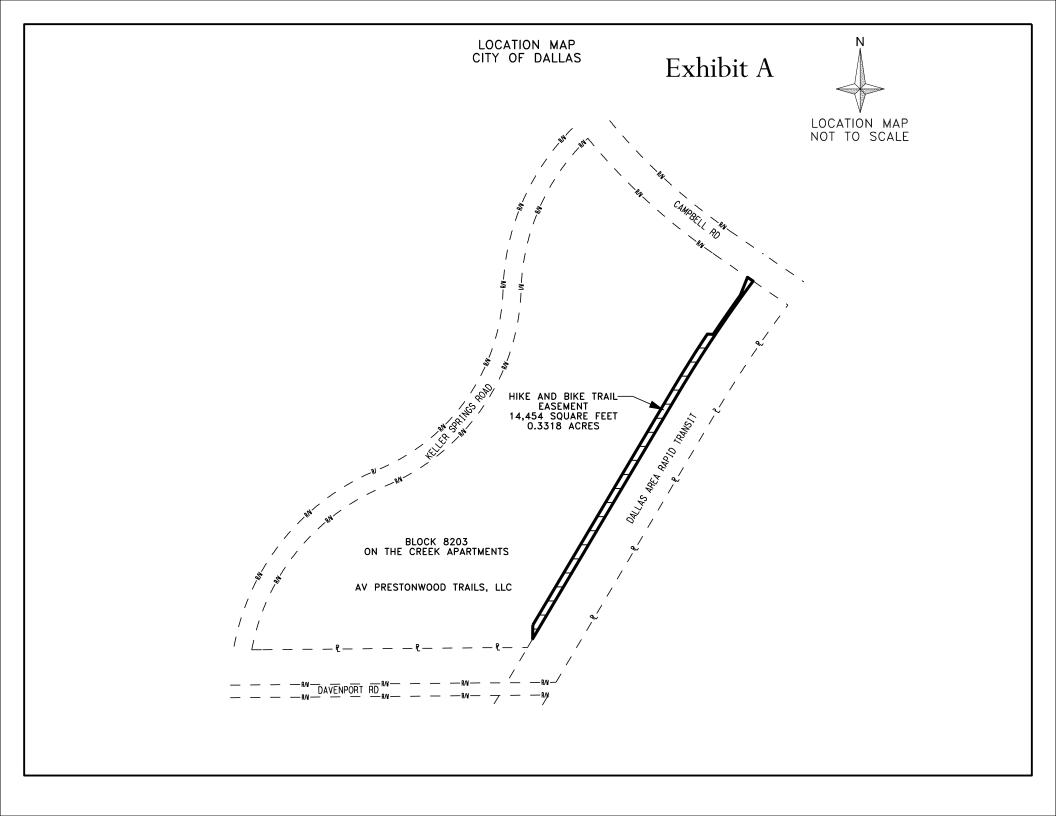
