BACKGROUND

On November 3, 2023, four bids were received for the construction of the Coombs Creek Extension Trail Improvements Project. This action will authorize a construction services contract with Northstar Construction, Inc., lowest responsible bidder of four, for the construction of the base bid, in the amount of \$567,750.00.

The scope of work for the Coombs Creek Extension Trail Improvements from Davis Street to Moss Park includes construction of the Coombs Creek Extension Trail consisting of 10-foot-wide concrete trail along Plymouth Road from Davis Street to Moss Park, including accessible ramps, pavement striping, pedestrian crossing improvements, drainage improvements, park trail head improvements and other associated improvements. Funding for this project was included in the 2017 Bond Program.

BACKGROUND

This item authorizes the acquisition of a hike and bike trail easement from AV Prestonwood Trails, LLC of approximately 14,454 square feet (0.33 acres) of land located at 6350 Keller Springs Road for the Cotton Belt Trail Project (Project) (**Exhibit A**). The total purchase price for this acquisition is \$17,500.00 based on an independent appraisal (\$14,500.00, plus closing costs and title expenses not to exceed \$3,000.00).

The hike and bike trail easement will be used for the Cotton Belt Trail Project. The Project is a collaboration between the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG), DART, and local governments, namely Grapevine, Coppell, Carrollton, Addison, Dallas, Richardson, and Plano. When completed, the Cotton Belt Trail will extend over twenty-four miles providing connections into many local governments' trail networks across the DFW area including the extensive Dallas Trail Network.

The Project has been designed and is being constructed concurrent with DART's Silver Line project. The construction of critical project construction areas is nearing completion for Phase 1. 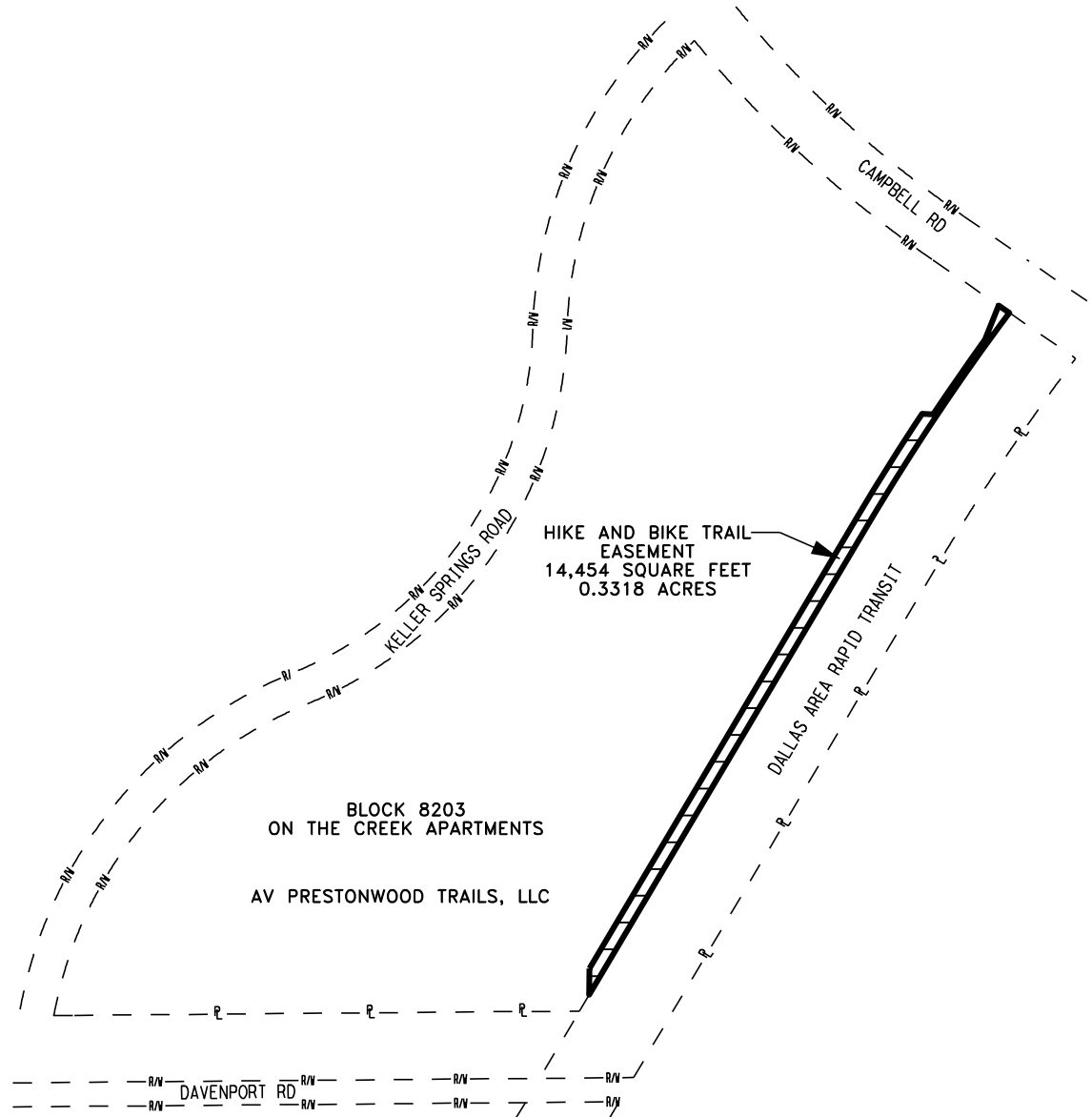

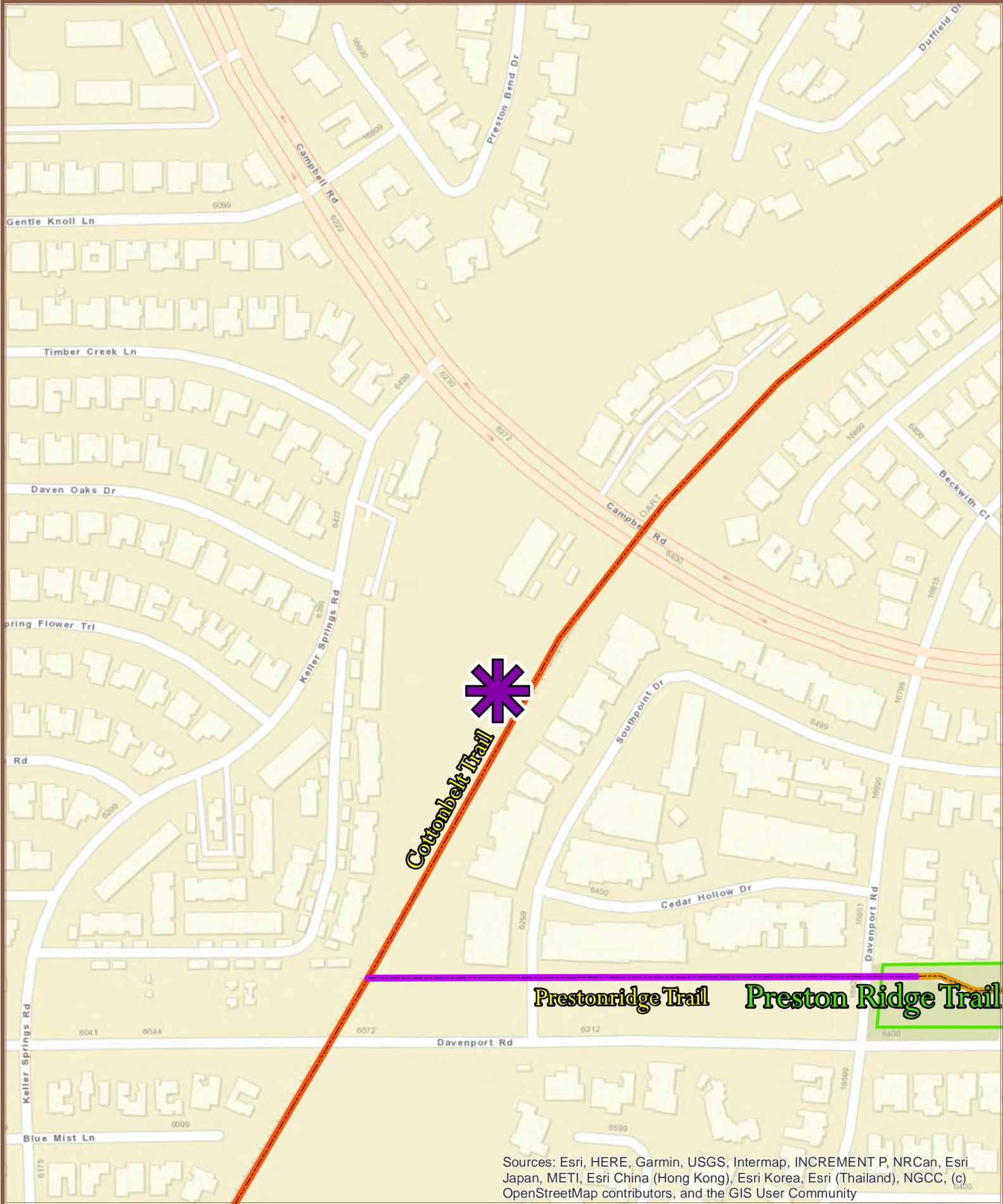
