<u>Agenda Item 1.</u> Trinity Forest Spine Trail – (2,7) A motion by JR Huerta, seconded by Scott Goldstein to authorize (1) Amendment #1 to the Project Specific Agreement with Dallas County, County Transportation Major Capital Improvement Projects 10233, for the purpose of providing funding for the Trinity Forest Spine Trail Phase 2 from the Santa Fe Trail just north of Tenison Park Golf Course to the Dallas Area Rapid Transit Lawnview Station located at 5900 Scyene Road; (2) the receipt and deposit of funds from Dallas County in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.00 for the County's share of the project cost in the Capital Gifts, Donation and Development Fund; and (3) execution of the agreement including all terms, conditions, and documents required by the agreement – Revenue: Capital Gifts, Donation and Development Fund \$2,000,000.00, was carried by a unanimous vote.

<u>Agenda Item 2.</u> Trinity Forest Spine Trail – (2,7) A motion by JR Huerta, seconded by Scott Goldstein, to Authorize (1) a correction to Resolution No. 21-1020, previously approved on June 9, 2021 with North Rock Construction, LLC to revise the funding to reflect the City equally dividing the costs with Dallas County for the Trinity Spine Trail from the Santa Fe Trail north of Tenison Park Golf Course to the DART Lawnview Station located at 5900 Scyene Road; (2) the receipt and deposit of funds from Dallas County in an amount not to exceed \$2,923,878.00; and (3) increase appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$2,923,878.00; and (3) increase appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$2,923,878.00 in the Capital, Gifts, and Donations Fund - Not to exceed \$5,847,756.00 - Financing: Park and Recreation Facilities (B) Fund (2017 General Obligation Bond Fund) (\$2,923,878.00) and Capital, Gifts, and Donation Fund (\$2,923,878.00), was carried by a unanimous vote.

<u>Agenda item 3.</u> Land Acquisition – (13) A motion by JR Huerta, seconded by Scott Goldstein, to authorize acquisition from Dallas Independent School District of approximately 360,143 square feet of residential unimproved land (approximately 7.7 acres) addressed as 10345 Webb Chapel Rd for development as a community park — Not to exceed \$4,240,740.00 (\$4,210,740.00 plus closing costs and title expenses not to exceed \$30,000.00) — Financing: General Fund, Park and Recreation (B) Fund, and Parkland Dedication Fund, was carried by a unanimous vote.
