Chair Adam McGough presented an overview of the COVID-19 situation in the City of Dallas and broader Dallas County. Chair McGough further detailed the need for the creation of the Ad Hoc Committee on COVID-19 Human and Social Recovery, and read a statement from Mayor Eric Johnson, tasking the committee with the following priorities to: (1) minimize the negative impact on the quality of life for residents of the City of Dallas, particularly the homeless, seniors and other vulnerable populations, and (2) monitor and ensure compliance with the City's emergency regulations and lay the groundwork for the long-term recovery from COVID-19.

2. Structure and Charges for Ad Hoc Committee on COVID-19 Human Social Recovery and Assistance Presenter(s): Chair Adam McGough

Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s): Chair Adam McGough invited comments and concerns regarding actions to take following the end of the COVID-19 situation.

3. Identify Specific Areas of Focus and Need

Presenter(s): Chair McGough

Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s): Chair Mendelsohn provided an overview of affected areas such as shelters, homeless centers, etc. Councilmember Gates shared that she will be reviewing needs of the Domestic Violence task force, which is scheduled to meet Tuesday, March 24th. City Attorney Chris Caso presented Amended Order of County Judge Clay Jenkins and fielded questions. Council members asked Mr. Caso if chiropractors, construction workers, and landscaping workers fall under the new order. Another question concerned whether retailers like Dillard's and Macy's that carry household items does it fall within definition of an essential business. It was noted that additional guidance would be provided in FAQs.

Office of Homeless Solutions (OHS)

The Office of Homeless Solutions has secured 50 hotel rooms to house guests starting tomorrow. OHS priority groups are:

- Persons experiencing homelessness, in need of quarantine
- Persons in shelters and on the "Priority Housing list"

Department of Code Compliance and Department Police Department

Both departments are working alongside to ensure residents are following temporary regulations towards COVID-19.

• Chief Hall gave an update on public safety and stated that the department is running low on sanitizers, Lysol wipes and are working with donors to provide more supplies.

311 Customer Service

There are two types of services request that residents can use to report violations to the recently enacted community gathering regulations:

- Emergency Regulations Violation
- Parks Emergency Regulation Violation
