[Tex. Govt. Code §551.071]
- 2. deliberating the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property if deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the city in negotiations with a third person. [Tex. Govt. Code §551.072]
- 3. deliberating a negotiated contract for a prospective gift or donation to the city if deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the city in negotiations with a third person. [Tex. Govt. Code §551.073]
- 4. deliberating the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee; or to hear a complaint or charge against an officer or employee unless the officer or employee who is the subject of the deliberation or hearing requests a public hearing. [Tex. Govt. Code §551.074]
- 5. deliberating the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation, of security personnel or devices. [Tex. Govt. Code §551.076]
- discussing or deliberating commercial or financial information that the city has received from a business prospect that the city seeks to have locate, stay or expand in or near the city and with which the city is conducting economic development negotiations; or deliberating the offer of a financial or other incentive to a business prospect. [Tex Govt. Code §551.087]
- deliberating security assessments or deployments relating to information resources technology, network security information, or the deployment or specific occasions for implementations of security personnel, critical infrastructure, or security devices. [Tex Govt. Code §551.089]

- To share the progress of the cleanup efforts at the former Blue Star Recycling site

- Blue Star Recycling ("Blue Star") failed to obtain necessary permissions
- Code Compliance investigated, confirmed violations, and issued notices of violation and citation for illegal land use
- Blue Star obtained certificate of occupancy (CO) for industrial use (outside) – an allowed use
- Subsequent inspections revealed Blue Star misrepresented its operations



Background (cont.)



- OEQS investigated environmental concerns, confirmed significant risks and noncompliance issues
- CAO filed a lawsuit seeking the closure of the business
 addressing stormwater, floodplain, and land use violations
- Building Inspection revoked CO and the CAO obtained temporary restraining order requiring operations to cease
- Court signed Agreed Final Judgment December 2020




Cleanup Dashboard Overview - Timeline



 - Land Acquisition \$0 Cost
 - Council/Community Engagement
 - Real Estate Due Diligence (if necessary)



Next Steps (cont.)



- Post Incident Planning and Actions:
 - Certificate of Occupancy Process
 - Land Uses and Zoning Processes
 - Field Staff Environmental Awareness Training
 - Enhance Task Forces and Enforcement
 - Closer coordination with Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) and other regulatory agencies on compliance and enforcement
