WHEREAS, the City Council has amended Chapter 12A, "Code of Ethics," to establish an inspector general position; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has provided authority to the city attorney to hire the inspector general.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to transfer funds in an amount not to exceed \$197,558.00 from General Fund Contingency, Fund 0001, Department NBG, Unit 1000, Revenue Code RTRF, to General Fund, Fund 0001, Department ATT, Unit 3496, Revenue Code 9229, and a clearing entry in the same amount to General Fund, Fund 0001, Department BMS, Balance Sheet Account 0991 (Debit) and to General Fund, Fund 0001, Department BMS, Balance Sheet Account 0950 (Credit).

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to increase appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$197,558.00, from \$17,814,203.00 to \$18,011,761.00 in the City Attorney's Office, General Fund, Fund 0001, Department ATT, Unit 3496, various Object Codes; and increase total General Fund revenue appropriations by \$197,558.00, from \$1,535,018,900.00 to \$1,535,216,458.00.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to create a new Inspector General position in the City Attorney's Office.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
