WHEREAS, plaintiff Texas Standard Construction, Ltd. filed a claim in the lawsuit styled <u>Texas Standard Construction</u>, Ltd. v. City of <u>Dallas</u>, Cause No. DC-20-08079, seeking compensation from the City of <u>Dallas</u> for emergency work it performed in response to a wastewater overflow in and around the 900 block of Robert B. Cullum Boulevard beginning on January 16, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the plaintiff has agreed to a proposed settlement of the claim whereby the City will pay Texas Standard Construction, Ltd., Riney Packard, PLLC, and all other persons having an interest in the settlement proceeds, the total amount of \$190,000.00; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the City to settle this lawsuit.

Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

**SECTION 1.** That the proposed settlement of the claim filed by Texas Standard Construction, Ltd. in the lawsuit styled <u>Texas Standard Construction</u>, <u>Ltd. v. City of Dallas</u>, Cause No. DC-20-08079, in an amount not to exceed \$190,000.00 is hereby approved.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to pay Texas Standard Construction, Ltd., Riney Packard, PLLC, and all other persons having an interest in the settlement proceeds, the amount of \$190,000.00 from Liability Reserve Fund, Fund 0192, Department ORM, Unit 3890, Object 3521, Vendor MVORM001.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
