WHEREAS, the City of Dallas (City) recognizes the emerging evolution of transportation infrastructure in the City and the importance of providing an integrated transportation system that balances the needs of pedestrians, transit, bicycles, and automobiles; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Dallas approved funding in the 2017 General Obligation Bond Program for streetscape and pedestrian improvements at the intersection of Pearl Street and Flora Street (the Project); and

WHEREAS, the City's total fixed Project budget is \$1,000,000.00 (Project Construction and Administrative Support Budget), to be funded by 2017 General Obligation Bond Funds on a future City Council Agenda; and

WHEREAS, the Dallas Arts District Foundation (DADF) has identified the Project as a priority and has agreed to perform the Project design plans at its sole expense and donate the completed Project design plans to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City and DADF, in the mutual interest of the City of Dallas, desire to enter into a contract establishing the terms for the donation of the Project design plans.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with DADF, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the donation of DADF-funded design plans for a City of Dallas 2017 General Obligation Bond Program streetscape and pedestrian improvements project located at the intersection of Pearl Street and Flora Street.

SECTION 2. That this contract is designated as Contract No. TRN-2021-00016803.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
