WHEREAS, it is now recommended that the City Manager be authorized to accept a grant from Better Cities for Pets to be used to be used to renovate the pavilion that is used as a multi-functional space for pets and potential adopters to meet during the grant period January 17, 2022 through July 29, 2022, in the amount of \$20,000.00.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept a grant in the amount of \$20,000.00 from Better Cities for Pets for the Keeping People and Pets Together Program, to be used to renovate the pavilion that is used as a multi-functional space for pets and potential adopters to meet during the grant period January 17, 2022 through July 29, 2022, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00 in the Better Cities for Pets January 2022 Keeping People and Pets Together Program, Better Cities for Pets Grant Funds, Fund P161, Department DAS, Unit 260C, Revenue Code 8411.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00 in the Better Cities for Pets January 2022 Keeping People and Pets Together Program, Better Cities for Pets Grant Funds, Fund P161, Department DAS, Unit 260C, Object 2280.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00 from the Better Cities for Pets January 2022 Keeping People and Pets Together Program, Better Cities for Pets Grant Funds, Fund P161, Department DAS, Unit 260C, Object 2280.

SECTION 5. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to reimburse to the granting agency any expenditure identified as ineligible. The City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

SECTION 6. That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all final Better Cities for Pets monitoring reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report.

SECTION 7. That this contract is designated as Contract No. DAS-2022-00017962.

SECTION 8. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
