Grocery Impact In Texas

Over 600,000 employees

Annual wages: Almost \$27 billion

Taxes paid in Texas: over \$13 billion

Example: 60,000 sq ft Supermarket

Requires 5-7 acres of land

- Parking requirement: two spaces/100 sq.ft. 300 spots
- Construction Building: \$8.1 million
- •Fixture/refrigeration/scanners: costs: \$5 million
- Site work: \$2 million
- -Starting inventory: \$200,000-\$300,000
- Permit fees for site work: \$100,000
- Impact fees to City: \$200,000

Permit fees for site: \$100,000

- Sign fee: \$500
- Landscaping costs: civil plans and testing \$250,000
- Zoning specialist/attorney costs: \$200,000
- Special architectural costs: \$225,000

Grocery Stores Pay Taxes

On an ongoing basis, store would pay taxes:

- Property Taxes
- Personal Property Taxes
- Inventory Taxes
- Unemployment Taxes
- Social Security/Medicare taxes for employees
