Draft Item 22-298

A public hearing to receive comments on the renewal of the Dallas juvenile curfew ordinance, which provides daytime and nighttime curfew hours for minors; and, at the close of the public hearing, consideration of an ordinance amending Chapter 31 of the Dallas City Code to reinstate and continue in effect the Dallas juvenile curfew ordinance - Financing: No cost consideration to the City

Background

Enforcement of the Dallas juvenile curfew ordinance began May 1, 1994. Section 370.002 of the Texas Local Government Code requires that the curfew ordinance be reviewed every three years after conducting public hearings to receive citizen comments on whether the curfew ordinance should be abolished, continued, or modified. The last renewal of the curfew ordinance was approved on February 27, 2019. and became effective March 4, 2019. This ordinance contained both a daytime and nighttime ordinance and changes that utilized the Community Courts Program in lieu of a fine. (The daytime curfew hours were added to the juvenile curfew ordinance and became effective on May 18, 2009.)
