WHEREAS, on April 27, 2022, City Council authorized a three-year service price agreement, with one two-year renewal option, for executive and professional search firms for multiple areas of expertise for the Department of Human Resources with POLIHIRE Strategy Corporation, Confidential Search Solutions LLC, SENSE Solutions, Inc. dba Korn Ferry Government Consulting Services, vTech Solutions, Inc., and Lincoln Leadership Advisors, LLC by Resolution No. 22-0655.

Now Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service price agreement with GovHR USA LLC (VS93683), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for executive and professional search firms for multiple areas of expertise for the Department of Human Resources for a term of three years in the estimated amount of \$819,650, with one two-year renewal option in a total estimated amount of \$300,982.50, in a total estimated amount of \$1,120,632.50. The amount payable pursuant to this service contract may exceed the estimated amount but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service contract during its term. Payments made to GovHR USA LLC, shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by GovHR USA LLC, under the service contract. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$1,120,632.50, but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term to GovHR USA LLC, from Service Contract No. PER-2021-00015935.

Initial Term: \$819,650.00

Renewal Option: \$300,982.50

Total \$1,120,632.50

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
