**WHEREAS**, on December 1, 2012, City Council authorized an Interlocal Agreement with Dallas County for the participation in the design and implementation of a new P25 compliant trunk radio system by Resolution No. 12-3046; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 1, 2012, City Council authorized a service contract for professional radio engineering services to the City in the assessment of the City's operational needs, develop specifications and requirements for a new P25 compliant trunk radio system and respond to Request for Competitive Sealed Proposal (RFCSP) questions and develop RFCSP amendments during the solicitation process by Resolution No. 12-3047; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 13, 2017, City Council authorized an Interlocal Agreement with Dallas County to share costs for the design, purchase, and implementation of a new P25 trunked radio system by Resolution No. 17-1907; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 13, 2017, City Council authorized a contract for the purchase and installation; fifteen-years of system maintenance and support of a replacement citywide radio system; and a five-year master agreement for radios and accessories with Motorola Solutions, Inc. by Resolution No. 17-1912; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 9, 2020, City Council authorized an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Irving for sharing of radio communication sites by Resolution No. 20-1944.

**WHEREAS**, On March 24, 2021, City Council authorized the City Manager to execute Interlocal Agreements with various cities to complete the City's P25 radio project by Resolution No. 21-0438.

Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

**SECTION 1**. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute all agreements necessary to grant permission to governmental entities to operate radio equipment attached or interfaced to the City's P25 radio system, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

**SECTION 2**. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
