WHEREAS, on November 10, 2021, City Council authorized the acceptance of a grant from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Federal Emergency Management Agency for the FY2021 Regional Catastrophic Preparedness Grant Program (Federal Award ID No. EMT2021-CA-00055-S01, CFDA No. 97.111) to provide for three-year funding for the salary and fringe benefits of one planner, and to fund activities related to providing resources to close known capability gaps in Housing and Logistics and Supply Chain Management, encouraging innovative regional solutions to issues related to catastrophic incidents, and building on existing regional efforts in the amount of \$945,859.00 for the period September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2024, by Resolution No. 21-1828.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service contract with Innovative Emergency Management dba IEM (VS0000082750), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for consulting services to assist in the development of a regional catastrophic preparedness framework for the Office of Emergency Management for a term of three years, in an amount not to exceed \$491,219.00. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed basis, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payments made to Innovative Emergency Management dba IEM shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Innovative Emergency Management dba IEM under the contract.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$491,219.00 (subject to annual appropriations) to Innovative Emergency Management dba IEM from the FY2021 Regional Catastrophic Preparedness Grant Program Fund, Fund F694, Department MGT, Unit 249C, Object 3099, Service Contract No. OEM-2022-00018527.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
