WHEREAS, Dallas Animal Services has identified expenses related to the Empty the Shelter event sponsored by Bissell Pet Foundation; and

WHEREAS, it is now recommended that the City Manager be authorized to accept a grant from Bissell Pet Foundation to be used for reimbursement for the adoption prep of 171 dogs and 24 cats adopted during the Empty the Shelters event for the period of May 2, 2022 through May 15, 2022, in an amount not to exceed \$18,300.00.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept a grant from Bissell Pet Foundation for Empty the Shelters in the amount of \$18,300.00, to be used for reimbursement in the adoption prep for each animal adopted during the Empty the Shelters event for the period May 2, 2022 through May 15, 2022, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$18,300.00 in the Bissell Pet Foundation May 2022 Empty the Shelters Fund, Fund P168, Department DAS, Unit 302C, Object 2280.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$18,300.00 in the Bissell Pet Foundation May 2022 Empty the Shelters Fund, Fund P168, Department DAS, Unit 302C, Revenue Code 8411.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$18,300.00 from the Bissell Pet Foundation May 2022 Empty the Shelters Fund, Fund P168, Department DAS, Unit 302C, Object 2280.

SECTION 5. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to reimburse to the granting agency any expenditure identified as ineligible. The City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

SECTION 6. That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all final Bissell Pet Foundation monitoring reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report.

SECTION 7. That this contract is designated as Contract No. DAS-2022-00020020.

SECTION 8. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
