WHEREAS, the JYNNEOS vaccine is approved for administration for the prevention of smallpox and monkeypox and is the primary vaccine being used in the U.S.; and

WHEREAS, Dallas County is requesting use of the West Dallas Multipurpose Center to administer the monkeypox vaccinations for the community; and

WHEREAS, the monkeypox vaccinations will be administered by Dallas County staff to community members per the guidelines and protocols established by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention; and

WHEREAS, Dallas County will administer the vaccinations without charge; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas will allow for the use of the West Dallas Multipurpose Center by Dallas County to administer the monkeypox vaccinations.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept an Interlocal Agreement between the City of Dallas and the Dallas County, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to allow **(1)** for the use of the facilities at the West Dallas Multipurpose Center, a facility of the City of Dallas, to provide the community with vaccinations for the monkeypox; and **(2)** to provide for the execution of the agreement and all terms, conditions and documents required by the agreement, for the period October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023, including mutual indemnity, waiver of jury trial, and venue,

SECTION 2. That there is no cost to the City of Dallas to allow for the use of the West Dallas Multipurpose Center by Dallas County.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed as needed.

SECTION 4. That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to provide additional information, adjust, and take other actions related to the implementation of the Interlocal Agreement as necessary to satisfy the terms of the agreement.

SECTION 5. That this contract is designated as Contract No. OCC-2022-00020313.

SECTION 6. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
