WHEREAS, on April 28, 2021, City Council authorized the acceptance of a grant from the Cities for Financial Empowerment Fund, Inc. for the Financial Empowerment Center Planning Grant in the amount of \$20,000.00 to support a Financial Empowerment Centers planning project for the period February 1, 2021 through January 30, 2022 by Resolution No. 21-0694; and

WHEREAS, on September 22, 2021, City Council authorized the FY22 Biennial Budget, inclusive of funding to support Financial Empowerment Centers by Resolution No. 21-1590.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service contract with Women In Need of Generous Support dba WiNGS (VS0000018190), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for financial counseling services at three financial empowerment centers for the Office of Community Care for a term of two years, in an amount not to exceed \$2,988,075. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed basis, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payments made to Women In Need of Generous Support dba WiNGS shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Women In Need of Generous Support dba WiNGS under the contract.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$2,988,075 (subject to annual appropriations) to Women In Need of Generous Support dba WiNGS from Service Contract No. OCC-2022-00019328.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
