WHEREAS, on September 28, 2022, City Council authorized an Interlocal Agreement with Dallas County through Southwestern Institute of Forensic Sciences at Dallas for the provision of forensic, drug, toxicological, environmental, and physical evidence analysis and other similar medical/forensic analytical services for the period October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023, in an amount not to exceed \$4,100,000.00, by Resolution No. 22-1475.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a cooperative purchasing agreement with Bode Cellmark Forensics, Inc. (VS0000056445) through the General Services Administration cooperative agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for sexual assault kits and processing services for the Police Department, for a term of three years, in the estimated amount of \$2,345,887.45. The amount payable pursuant to this cooperative purchasing agreement may exceed the estimated amount but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this cooperative purchasing agreement during its term. Payments made to Bode Cellmark Forensics, Inc. shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Bode Cellmark Forensics, Inc. under the cooperative purchasing agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$2,345,887.45 (subject to annual appropriations), but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this cooperative purchasing agreement during its term to Bode Cellmark Forensics, Inc. from Cooperative Purchasing Agreement Contract No. DPD-2022-00019996.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
