WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Texas declared Dallas County a natural disaster area on August 23, 2022 pursuant to State Law; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas, experienced property damage caused by the severe weather and flood events on August 21, 2022 and August 22, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas has determined that a need exists to repair damaged city facilities that are insured, and the city must respond to prevent a public health safety hazard; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager is authorized to make certain adjustments to continue recovery efforts.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to increase appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$6,810,500.00 in the 2022 Severe Weather and Flooding Fund, Fund 0790, Department BMS, Unit 2394 Object 3099 to repair damage to city facilities as a result of the severe weather event.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to transfer funds not to exceed \$6,810,500.00 from General Fund Contingency Reserve Fund, Fund 0001, Department NBG, Unit 1000, Revenue Code RTRF, to 2022 Severe Weather and Flooding Fund, Fund 0790, Department BMS, Unit 2394, Revenue Code 9229; and a clearing entry, in the same amount, to General Fund Contingency Reserve Fund, Fund 0001, Department BMS, Balance Sheet Account 0991 (Debit) and to Fund 0001, Department BMS, Balance Sheet Account 0950 (Credit).

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to transfer funds not to exceed \$6,060,500 from 2022 Severe Weather and Flooding Fund, Fund 0790, Department BMS, Unit 2394, Revenue Code 9229 to General Fund Contingency Reserve Fund, Fund 0001, Department NBG, Unit 1000, Revenue Code RTRF, and a clearing entry, in the same amount, to General Fund Contingency Reserve Fund, Fund 0001, Department BMS, Balance Sheet Account 0991 (Credit) and to Fund 0001, Department BMS, Balance Sheet Account 0950 (Debit).

SECTION 4. That the City Manager and Chief Financial Officer are authorized to take all actions necessary to file insurance claims.

SECTION 5. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
