**WHEREAS,** on September 22, 2021, City Council authorized the final reading and adoption of the appropriation ordinance for the FY 2021-22 City of Dallas Operating, Capital, and Grant & Trust Budgets, which included the ARPA funds from the U.S. Department of Treasury for the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds by Resolution No. 21-1590.

Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service contract with Group 4 Architecture, Research + Planning, Inc. (VC25996), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for consulting services to develop facility and strategic master plans for the Library for a term of one year, in an amount not to exceed \$495,000. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed basis, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payments made to Group 4 Architecture, Research + Planning, Inc. shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Group 4 Architecture under the contract.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$495,000 to Group 4 Architecture, Research + Planning, Inc. as follows:
