WHEREAS, this Regional Asset Transfer Addendum (“Addendum”) is intended to amend and supplement the Local Administrative Agreement (LAA) by approving the use of Texas Anti-Gang Center Grant No. 2848908 Funds awarded by the Office of the Governor of Texas Public Safety Office, Criminal Justice Division and Homeland Security Grants Division (the “TAG Grant Funds”) for the purpose of purchasing products, equipment or property (collectively the “Asset(s)”) on behalf of Constituent Organizations; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Richland Hills by and through its Police Department (“Recipient”), pursuant to the LAA, is the recipient of the TAG Grant Funds, acts as fiduciary for all parties in making purchases using TAG Grant Funds on behalf of the Constituent Organizations for the City of Dallas through the Dallas Police Department; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Dallas to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with North Texas Anti-Gang Center (TAG).

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Local Administrative Agreement Regional Transfer Addendum and a letter of intent with Texas Anti-Gang Center, approved as to form by the City Attorney, through North Richland Hills for the purpose of purchasing products, equipment or property for the period September 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023.

SECTION 2. That this Interlocal Agreement with TAG is designated as Contract No. DPD-2023-00020984.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
