Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That _____ is hereby appointed Interim City Attorney, effective at the close of business on February 28, 2023, to serve until the City Council selects and appoints the City Attorney. During this interim appointment period, _____ shall have the full powers and duties of the City Attorney as provided in the City Charter and ordinances and shall be paid an annual base salary of _____, [plus an additional interim assignment pay of _____ percent of _____ annual base salary] while serving in this capacity.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
