WHEREAS, it is imperative to meet the growing demands on airport operations; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Aviation strive to improve the quality of service and response to emergency calls; and

WHEREAS, the co-location of the two critical functions is required to improve its ability to collect, analyze, and share information between Airport Emergency Operation Center (AEOC)/Airport Operation Center (AOC) quickly and face-to-face during emergency management; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to authorize an architectural services contract with Exp U.S. Services Inc. to provide design services for the AEOC/AOC and bid phase services at Dallas Love Field.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an architectural services contract with exp US Services, Inc., approved as to form by the City Attorney, to provide design services for the Airport Emergency Operation Center/Airport Operation Center and bid phase services at Dallas Love Field.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$249,708.00 to exp US Services, Inc. in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract from the Aviation Fund, Fund 0130, Department AVI, Unit 7720, Object 4112, Activity AAIP, Program AVIW7720, Commodities 86465, 90500, 91075, 90652, 91240, 93673, 90600, Encumbrance/Contract No. CX-AVI-2022-00019661, Vendor VS89221

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
