WHEREAS, on November 28, 2018, City Council authorized a three-year service contract for maintenance and support of the existing multiple vendor reading system software application and meter reading handheld computers for the Water Utilities Department with Itron Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$178,805.43, by Resolution No. 18-1702; and

WHEREAS, on August 26, 2020, Administrative Action No. 21-5236 authorized to extend the term of the service contract with Itron, Inc for maintenance and support of the existing multiple vendor reading system software application and meter reading handheld computers from September 11, 2021 to March 12, 2023, in an amount not to exceed \$44,701.29, from \$178,805.43 to \$223,506.72.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service price agreement with Itron, Inc. (267549), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for maintenance and support of the existing field collection reading system software application and meter reading handheld devices for the Water Utilities Department for a term of five years, in the estimated amount of \$1,131,636.41. The amount payable pursuant to this service price agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term. Payments made to Itron, Inc. shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Itron, Inc. under the service price agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$1,131,636.41, but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term to Itron, Inc. from Service Price Agreement Contract No. DWU-2022-00018267.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
