WHEREAS, the federal off-system bridge program is administered by the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to replace or rehabilitate structurally deficient and functionally obsolete (collectively referred to as deficient) bridges located on public roads and streets off the designated state highway system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas, hereinafter referred to as the Local Government owns bridges located at Military Parkway at White Rock Creek Tributary, National Bridge Inventory (NBI) Structure No. 1805709M5880021, State Control-Section-Job (CSJ) No. 0918-47-425; and

WHEREAS, a project to remedy the bridge is included in the currently approved program of projects as authorized by Texas Transportation Commission Minute Order No. 116073. Dated August 31st, 2021; and

WHEREAS, federally-eligible items of work for this project are approved for 100% federal and state funding through the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) as well as the Highway Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Program; and

WHEREAS, the typical estimated local match fund participation requirement for federally eligible items of work is waived in full for CSJ No. 0918-47-425; and

WHEREAS, any non-eligible items of work will be paid by the Local Government; and

WHEREAS, the TxDOT is the lead agency to administer the design and the construction of the project; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to authorize an Advance Funding Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) (CSJ No. 0918-47-425) for the replacement or rehabilitation of the Military Parkway Bridge over White Rock Creek Tributary.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an Advance Funding Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) (CSJ No. 0918-47-425), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the replacement or rehabilitation of the Military Parkway Bridge over White Rock Creek Tributary.

SECTION 2. That the typical estimated local match fund participation requirement for federally eligible items of work is waived in full for CSJ 0918-47-425, the City hereby commits to spending City Funds for any non-eligible items of work.

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SECTION 3. That this contract is designated as Contract No. PBW-2023-00021421.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
