**WHEREAS,** Senate Bill 1827 (2021) required the State of Texas to establish a fund to receive and distribute payments required by settlements against opioid manufacturers and distributers; and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Opioid Abatement Trust Fund was established to distribute funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Opioid Abatement Council was established to ensure that money recovered by the state is allocated fairly and spent to remediate the opioid crisis statewide; and

**WHEREAS**, Cities and Counties will receive 15 percent of the available funds based on a formula that includes "opioid instances"; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has established the Opioid Strike Force to prioritize implementation of the opioid settlement funds.

Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to increase appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$941,732.69 in the Opioid Settlement Fund, Fund 0821, Department MGT, Unit 7201, Object 3099 to respond to the opioid related harm.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit future deposits from the Texas Opioid Abatement Trust Fund into the Opioid Settlement Fund, Fund 0821, Department BMS, Unit 5819, Revenue Code 8477.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
