**WHEREAS,** on April 27, 2016, the City Council authorized a three-year service contract for traffic counting services with Quality Traffic Data, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$318,000, by Resolution No. 16-0614; and

**WHEREAS,** on April 30, 2019, Administrative Action No. 19-5878 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 1 for a one-year extension with Quality Traffic Data, LLC for traffic counting services for Department of Transportation, with zero cost, having no effect on the contract amount; and

**WHEREAS,** on January 15, 2020, Administrative Action No. 20-0061 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 2 for a one-year extension with Quality Traffic Data, LLC for traffic counting services for Department of Transportation, with zero cost, having no effect on the contract amount; and

**WHEREAS,** on May 28, 2021, Administrative Action No. 21-0800 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 3 for a one-year extension with Quality Traffic Data, LLC for traffic counting services for Department of Transportation, with zero cost, having no effect on the contract amount; and

**WHEREAS,** on May 26, 2022, Administrative Action No. 22-0504 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 4 for a one-year extension with Quality Traffic Data, LLC for traffic counting services for Department of Transportation, with zero cost, having no effect on the contract amount.

## Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service contract with National Data and Surveying Services, Inc. (VC27551), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for traffic counting services for the Department of Transportation for a term of three years, in an amount not to exceed \$1,833,750, with two one-year renewal options in a total amount of \$1,302,995, in a total amount not to exceed \$3,136,745. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed basis, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payments made to National Data and Surveying Services, Inc. shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by National Data and Surveying Services, Inc. under the contract.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$3,136,745 (subject to annual appropriations) to National Data and Surveying Services, Inc. from Service Contract No. TRN-2022-00019924.
