WHEREAS, a lawsuit styled Bridgette Dancy and Elvis Brown v. City of Dallas, Cause No. DC-21-06901 was filed by the plaintiffs, Bridgette Dancy and Elvis Brown, seeking compensation from the City of Dallas for alleged bodily injuries and other damages sustained in an automobile collision on August 31, 2020, involving a Dallas Department of Sanitation Services employee operating a city-owned vehicle; and

WHEREAS, Plaintiff Elvis Brown has agreed to a proposed settlement of his claim whereby the City will pay Elvis Brown, Miguel Cazarez, Witherite Law Group, and all other persons and entities having an interest in the settlement proceeds, the total amount of \$40,000.00; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interest to settle the claims of Elvis Brown in this lawsuit.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the proposed partial settlement of the lawsuit styled Bridgette Dancy and Elvis Brown v. City of Dallas, Cause No. DC-21-06901, in an amount not to exceed \$40,000.00 is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to pay Elvis Brown, Miguel Cazarez, Witherite Law Group, and all other persons and entities having an interest in the settlement proceeds, the amount of \$40,000.00 from the Liability Reserve Fund, Fund 0192, Department ORM, Unit 3890, Object 3521, Vendor MVORM001.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
