WHEREAS, on October 8, 2019, the City Council authorized a two-year cooperative subscription agreement for a web-based law enforcement training system for the Police Department with PCMG, Inc. dba PCM Gov, Inc. through the Texas Association of School Boards cooperative agreement, in the estimated amount of \$240,646.40, by Resolution No. 19-1595; and

WHEREAS, On February 23, 2022, the City Council Authorized a three-year cooperative purchasing agreement for web-based law enforcement training subscriptions for the Police Department with Lexipol, LLC through the Education Service Center Region 19 cooperative agreement by Resolution No 22-0400.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a cooperative purchasing agreement with Lexipol, LLC (VC23873) through the Sourcwell cooperative agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for web-based law enforcement training subscriptions for the Police Department for a term of three years, in the estimated amount of \$401,310.00. The amount payable pursuant to this cooperative purchasing agreement may exceed the estimated amount but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this cooperative purchasing agreement during its term. Payments made to Lexipol, LLC shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Lexipol, LLC under the cooperative purchasing agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$401,310.00, but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this cooperative purchasing agreement during its term to Lexipol, LLC from Cooperative Purchasing Agreement Contract No. DPD-2024-00024103.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
