BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the bid submitted by Oscar Renda Contracting, Inc., in the amount of \$43,186,835.00, for doing the work covered by the plans, specifications, and contract documents, Contract No. 19-433, be accepted.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract with Oscar Renda Contracting, Inc., approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the installation of a 72-inch diameter water transmission pipeline along Broadway Street and Madill Railroad corridor from the Elm Fork Water Treatment Plant to Crosby Road, in an amount not to exceed \$43,186,835.00.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$43,186,835.00 to Oscar Renda Contracting, Inc. from the Water Capital Improvement E Fund, Fund 3115, Department DWU, Unit PW40, Object 4550, Program 719433, Encumbrance/Contract No. CX-DWU-2019-00010695, Vendor 244607.
