**WHEREAS**, the Management Services/Office of Community Care is administering the Child Care Services Program which initially began in October 1985; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 26, 2019, City Council adopted the FY 2019-20 HUD Consolidated Plan Budget for the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Grant Funds for the following programs: Community Development Block Grant, HOME Investment Partnerships Program, Emergency Solutions Grant, Housing Opportunities for Person with AIDS Grant, and Program Income by FY 2019-20, by Resolution No. 19-0886; and

**WHEREAS**, the City will make monthly partial payments to the current and new childcare providers; and

**WHEREAS**, the Early Childhood and Out-of-School Time Services Program pays a portion of childcare expenses for working parents whose income falls in the low-to-moderate range of Community Development Block Grant eligibility; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the City Council to approve contracts with the providers to facilitate payment.

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute contracts with fully-licensed childcare providers, listed in Exhibit A, and with any other fully-licensed childcare providers, approved as to form by the City Attorney, pursuant to the Early Childhood and Out-of-School Time Services Program administered by the Office of Community Care, selected by eligible parents whose income falls in the low-to-moderate income range of Community Development Block Grant funding eligibility and who otherwise meet the requirements of the Early Childhood and Out-of-School Time Services Program for the period October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020, and execute any and all documents required by the contract.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to make payments of \$50.00 per week per child to fully-licensed childcare providers for working parents and pay to fully-licensed childcare providers 100% of the cost for childcare services for eligible teen parents who are enrolled in high school full time, listed in Exhibit A, and to other fully-licensed childcare providers who meet the requirements of the Early Childhood and Out-of-School Time Services Program, in an amount not to exceed \$336,081.00 from Fund CD19, Department MGT, Unit 909D, Object 3070.

**SECTION 3.** That the contracts be designated as the Contract Number listed in Exhibit A.
