WHEREAS, on November 7, 2006, Dallas voters approved the use of General Obligation Bonds to acquire property for future City facilities; and

WHEREAS, Maria S. Barba will be displaced as a direct result of this property acquisition and will vacate the property; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 39A of the Dallas Code of the City of Dallas provides moving expense and replacement housing payments for individuals displaced by the City of Dallas property acquisition activities; and

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2019, the City Council authorized the acquisition of real property at 703 Pontiac Avenue located in the Cadillac Heights neighborhood, to be used in conjunction with the construction of City service and maintenance facilities.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That Maria S. Barba will be displaced in conjunction with the Cadillac Heights Phase II Project and is entitled to moving expense and replacement housing payments pursuant to Chapter 39A of the Dallas Code of the City of Dallas.

SECTION 2. That Maria S. Barba is eligible to receive a moving expense payment in an amount up to \$2,050.00 and a replacement housing payment in an amount up to \$85,400.00.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$87,450.00 to Maria S. Barba for moving expense and last resort calculated replacement housing payments.
