**WHEREAS,** Chapter 2, Article X of the Dallas City Code establishes a Public Art Program to include works of art and design services of artists in certain City capital improvement projects; and

**WHEREAS,** in carrying out the intent of the Public Art Program, the Office of Cultural Affairs, working with the Public Art Committee, has identified a public art project to complement the Pike Park located at 2807 Harry Hines Boulevard; and

**WHEREAS,** Seth Vandable was selected for the project and was recommended by the Public Art Committee and the Arts and Culture Advisory Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, \$59,348.00 is available from the 2017 Bond Funds to support the fabrication and installation of a freestanding, outdoor sculpture at Pike Park.

## Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Seth Vandable, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the fabrication and installation of a site-specific, freestanding, outdoor sculpture at Pike Park located at 2807 Harry Hines Boulevard, in an amount not to exceed \$59,348.00.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$59,348.00 to Seth Vandable from the Park and Recreation Facilities (B) Fund, Fund 1V00, Department PKR, Unit PA56, Object 4425, Program PK17PA56, Encumbrance/Contract No. MASC-OCA-2019-00010906, Vendor VS100128.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
