**WHEREAS**, it became necessary to supplement City Forces for maintenance and street improvements throughout the city; and

**WHEREAS**, bid specifications were developed and publicly advertised for competitive bids associated with the 36-Month Maintenance & Street Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, bids were structured with a base bid and Additive Alternate for the installation of an Intelligent Transportation Systems Conduit in the City of Dallas' Public Right-of-Way; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 28, 2019, three bids were received for the construction of the 36-Month Maintenance & Street Improvements Project as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract with Heritage Materials, LLC, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to provide construction services for the 36-Month Maintenance & Street Improvements Project for FY 2020-2022, in an amount not to exceed \$154,865,242.50 (subject to annual appropriations), this being the lowest responsive bid received as indicated by the tabulation of bids.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit funds in an amount not to be exceed \$1,318,627.27 from Dallas County in the Capital Projects Reimbursement Fund, Fund 0556, Department PBW, Unit W179, Revenue Code 6499.

**SECTION 3.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$154,865,242.50 (subject to annual appropriations) to Heritage Materials, LLC as follows:
