WHEREAS, on April 26, 2017, City Council authorized a Memorandum of Understanding with Metro Dallas Homeless Alliance (MDHA) for continued participation in the local Homeless Management Information System (HMIS), effective April 1, 2017; a Subscription Services Agreement with Pieces Technology, Inc., for use of the Pieces Iris™ software solution being implemented by MDHA as the new HMIS, effective April 1, 2017; and execution of any and all documents required for participation in the HMIS by Resolution No. 17-0713.

Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service contract with Metro Dallas Homeless Alliance (517577), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for access to the Dallas Homeless Response System Analysis and Reporting System for a term of three years, in an amount not to exceed \$450,000. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payment to Metro Dallas Homeless Alliance shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Metro Dallas Homeless Alliance under the contract.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$450,000 (subject to annual appropriations) to Metro Dallas Homeless Alliance from Service Contract No. POM-2020-00012757.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
