### Recap of the 86<sup>th</sup> Session of the Texas Legislature

- Over 2,000 bills related to cities were filed and many of them were preemptive
- High-priority preemption legislation that passed includes:
  - SB 2 (Bettencourt/Burrows): Revenue Cap
  - SB 1152 (Hancock/Phelan): Telecom Franchise Fees
  - HB 1631 (Stickland/Hall): Red Light Cameras
  - HB 2439 (Phelan/Buckingham): Building Materials



#### **Senate Interim Charges**

- Lobbying
- Low-Income Housing Tax Credit Program
- Natural Disaster Funding
- Network Nodes in Public Rights of Way (SB 1004 85R)
- Revenue Caps (SB 2 86R)
- Vaping



#### **House Interim Charges**

- Economic Development & the Workforce
- Local Sales and Use Tax
- Homelessness
- Paid Sick Leave
- Short Term Rentals
- Telecommunication Fees (SB 1152 86R)



## Agenda Development Timeline for the 87<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session (2020 – 2021)

- Throughout the year: Monitor interim committee charges
- Jan. 2020: Solicited initial legislative priorities from City Council
- May 2020: Solicit legislative initiatives from executive leadership and department directors
- Jun. Aug. 2020: Meet with executive leadership and department directors to review draft legislative agenda



## **Agenda Development Timeline for the 87<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session (2020 – 2021)**

- Sept. 2020: Finalize draft legislative agenda
- Oct. 2020: Present draft legislative agenda to Ad Hoc Committee on Legislative Affairs
- Nov. 2020: City Council adoption of legislative agenda
- Jan. 2021: Start of legislative session
- Feb. 2021: Dallas Legislative Reception in Austin
- May 2021: Sine die
