Since officers on the Dallas Police Force have been wearing body worn cameras, civilians in the City of Dallas have been asking if video footage can be released to the public after an officer involved shooting.

With the overhaul of the police oversight system in Dallas, the Police Monitor will be able to review video footage after such incidents.

The Community Police Review Board would like to start having discussions about this issue in the hopes of bringing a recommendation to the Dallas Police Department regarding public release of video footage after an office involved shooting. This will be the first discussion of the Board regarding this issue.
