WHEREAS, on October 24, 2018, City Council authorized a management contract with Fair Park First for management and operation of Fair Park for the Park and Recreation Department for a term of twenty years, with two five-year extension options by Resolution No. 18-1531; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary for official action to be taken by the City Council to define services to be received and authorize payment of funding allocations to Texas Discovery Gardens during the 2020 calendar year.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That a contract with the Texas Discovery Gardens totaling \$145,862.00 be approved.

SECTION 2. That the President of the Park and Recreation Board and the City Manager are hereby authorized to execute a twelve-month funding agreement with Texas Discovery Gardens, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to provide community outreach services, horticulture information services and presentations at community centers and special facilities within the city of Dallas for the period of January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020, in an amount not to exceed \$145,862.00.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$145,862.00 to Texas Discovery Gardens from General Fund, Fund 0001, Department PKR, Unit 5206, Object 3072, Encumbrance/Contract No. PKR-2019-00008359, Vendor 219134, as vouchers are processed by the Park and Recreation Department.

SECTION 4. That the services to be provided are: community outreach services, horticulture information services and presentations at community centers and special facilities.

SECTION 5. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
