WHEREAS, Christopher J. Caso was appointed Interim City Attorney, effective September 5, 2018; and

WHEREAS, on September 5, 2018, upon appointing Christopher J. Caso Interim City Attorney, the City Council approved an additional interim assignment pay of five percent (5%), and a retention payment to be paid in four installments ending January 1, 2019, by Resolution No. 18-1218; and

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2019, City Council provided an additional retention payment to Christopher J. Caso during the time it takes to select a permanent City Attorney beginning on April 1, 2019 and ending on December 1, 2019, by Resolution No. 19-0465; and

WHEREAS, on December 11, 2019, City Council authorized an additional retention payment for Christopher J. Caso, Interim City Attorney, during the time it takes to select a permanent City Attorney, payable in three equal installments beginning on January 1, 2020, and ending on March 31, 2020, or until a new City Attorney is appointed by Resolution No. 19-1939; and

WHEREAS, because of the length of the search and selection process, the City Council has determined that it is necessary to provide an additional retention payment beginning on April 1, 2020, and ending on April 30, 2020, or until a new City Attorney is appointed.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That during this interim appointment period, Christopher J. Caso shall have the full powers and duties of the City Attorney as provided in the City Charter and ordinances and shall continue to receive his base salary and additional interim assignment pay of five percent (5%) of his annual base salary while serving in this capacity and an additional retention payment of ten thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$10,000.00), payable in one payment of ten thousand and 00/100 (\$10,000.00), beginning April 1, 2020, and ending on April 30, 2020, or until a new City Attorney is appointed.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
