WHEREAS, funding was awarded to the City of Dallas for the BJA FY19 Gulf States Regional Law Enforcement Technology Assistance Initiative Grant, Grant No. 2020-RZ-BX-0017 to enhance information and criminal intelligence for the Dallas Police Department Dallas Fusion Center (DFC); and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Dallas to accept such funding.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for and accept funding for the BJA FY19 Gulf States Regional Law Enforcement Technology Assistance Initiative Grant (Grant No. 2020-RZ-BX-0017, CFDA No. 16.843) from the U.S Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs, the Bureau of Justice Assistance in the amount of \$150,000.00 to enhance information and criminal intelligence sharing between local law enforcement agencies and their local fusion centers for the period of December 1, 2019 through November 30, 2021; and execute the grant agreement and all terms, conditions, and documents required by the grant agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$150,000.00 in the BJA FY19 Gulf States Regional Law Enforcement Technology Assistance Initiative Grant Fund, Fund F619, Department DPD, Unit 5078, Object 3099.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit funds in an amount not to exceed \$150,000.00 in the BJA FY19 Gulf States Regional Law Enforcement Technology Assistance Initiative Grant Fund, Fund F619, Department DPD, Unit 5078, Revenue Code 6506.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$150,000.00 from the BJA FY19 Gulf States Regional Law Enforcement Technology Assistance Initiative Grant Fund, Fund F619, Department DPD, Unit 5078, Object Code 3099.

SECTION 5. That in the event of loss or misuse of funds, the grantee will return grant funds to the DOJ, Office of Justice Programs in full. The City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

SECTION 6. That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all the DOJ, Office of Justice Programs, the Bureau of Justice Assistance, final monitoring reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report.

SECTION 7. That this contract is designated as Contract No. DPD-2020-00012999.

SECTION 8. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
