BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That (1) a master agreement for the purchase of recreational vehicles to serve as quarantine shelters for first responder employees is authorized with Fun Town RV LP, (VC21319), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for a term of three years, in the estimated amount of \$1,391,300.00 and; (2) the ratification of \$106,400 for the immediate purchase of recreational vehicles to serve as quarantine shelters for first responder employees with Fun Town RV LP, in a total estimated amount of \$1,497,700.00. The amount payable pursuant to this master agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this master agreement during its term. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Purchasing Agent is authorized, upon appropriate request and documented need by a user department, to issue a purchase order for recreational vehicles to serve as quarantine shelters for first responder employees. If a written contract is required or requested for any or all purchases of recreational vehicles to serve as quarantine shelters for first responder employees under the master agreement instead of individual purchase orders, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in a total estimated amount of at least \$1,497,700.00, but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this master agreement during its term to Fun Town RV LP from Master Agreement Contract No. EFM-2020-00013319.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to execute a buy back option where the vendor agrees to purchase the recreational vehicles back once the City's use is completed.

SECTION 5. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
