WHEREAS, the National Park Service has made funding available to the City of Dallas under the African American Civil Rights Grant program to document, interpret, and preserve the sites related to African American Civil Rights in the 20th Century; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas will benefit from the funds for creation and sharing of a body of research and educational material about the 1936 Hall of Negro Life at Fair Park.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for and accept a grant from the U.S. Department of the Interior, National Park Service for the FY 2020 African American Civil Rights History Grant (TBD Grant No. P20AP00147, CFDA No. 15.904) in the amount of \$50,000.00 to create and share a body of research and educational material about the 1926 Hall of Negro Life at Fair Park for the period October August 1, 2020 through September August 30, 20223; and execute the grant agreement with the National Park Service and all terms, conditions, and documents required by the agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00 in the NPS AACR Grant Fund, Fund F623, Department OCA, Unit 5089, Object 3070.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00 into the NPS AACR Grant Fund, Fund F623, Department OCA, Unit 5089, Revenue Code 6506.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00 from the NPS AACR Grant Fund, Fund F623, Department OCA, Unit 5089, Object 3070.

SECTION 5. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to provide a local cash match in an amount not to exceed \$17,500.00 (subject to appropriations) from NPS AACR Grant Fund, Fund F623, Department OCA, Unit 5092, Object Code 8411 in accordance to the attached Schedule A.

SECTION 6. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to provide an In-Kind Contribution in the approximate amount of \$4,500.00, in accordance to the attached Schedule A.

SECTION 57. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to reimburse to the granting agency any expenditure identified as ineligible. The City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

SECTION 68. That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all final granting agency monitoring reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report.

SECTION 79. That this grant agreement is designated as Contract No. OCA-2020-00013427.

SECTION 810. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
