WHEREAS, Dallas Animal Services has identified expenses related to at-risk animals affected by COVID-19. PetSmart Charities Inc. has awarded the City of Dallas grant funds to use for, but are not limited to, animal food; and

WHEREAS, it is now recommended that the City Manager be authorized to accept a grant from PetSmart Charities Inc. to support the at-risk shelter animals affected by COVID-19 for the Department of Dallas Animal Services, in the amount of \$20,000.00 for six months from the execution date.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept a grant from PetSmart Charities Inc. to support the at-risk shelter animals affected by COVID-19 for the Department of Dallas Animal Services in the amount of \$20,000.00 for six months from the execution date; and execute the grant agreement and all terms, conditions, and documents required by the grant agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00 in the PetSmart COVID-19 At Risk Shelter Animals Fund, Fund PC04, Department DAS, Unit 975C, Revenue Code 8411.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00 in the PetSmart COVID-19 At Risk Shelter Animals Fund, Fund PC04, Department DAS, Unit 975C, Object 2241.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00 from the PetSmart COVID-19 At Risk Shelter Animals Fund, Fund PC04, Department DAS, Unit 975C, Object 2241.

SECTION 5. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to reimburse to the granting agency any expenditure identified as ineligible. The City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

SECTION 6. That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all final PetSmart Charities Inc. monitoring reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report.

SECTION 7. That this contract is designated as Contract No. DAS-2020-00013628.

SECTION 8. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
